COMMUNIQUE OF THE ANNUAL CONFERENCE OF THE NUPE CHRISTIAN FELLOWSHIP INTERNATIONAL HELD AT THE CATHEDRAL CHURCH OF ST. JOHN, BIDA, NIGER STATE, FROM 15TH-18TH APRIL, 2021.

THEME: BEHOLD, I WILL DO A NEW THING IN YOUR MIDST (ISAIAH 43:19)

1.0 PREAMBLE
